Robert Marcato, 19, who moved in with TV's famously dysfunctional family last year, has left the premises.

After being unofficially adopted by Sharon and Ozzy when his mother died from cancer, Robert became close pals with recently reformed party boy Jack, 17, and was treated like a family member at the Osbournes' Beverly Hills mansion.

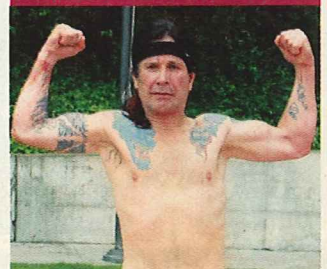
Sharon confirmed the news of the exit exclusively to *In Touch* from her studio in L.A. "Robert moved out because he needed his space," she said. "He's 20 next month, and wanted to be out on his own. We still see him all the time and he will always be part of our family. Nothing has changed."

There's never a dull moment at the Osbournes', despite the fact that Jack — and his dad — are in the early stages of recovery from substance abuse.

The gang is now locked in an ongoing feud with their Beverly Hills neighbors after Jack was accused of splattering the property with a paintball gun. Police were called when Jack — angered by the sound of a tennis ball being smashed around next door — shot off a paintball from behind a bush, covering the neighbors' tennis court with pink paint.
