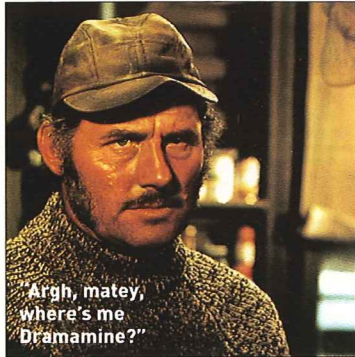
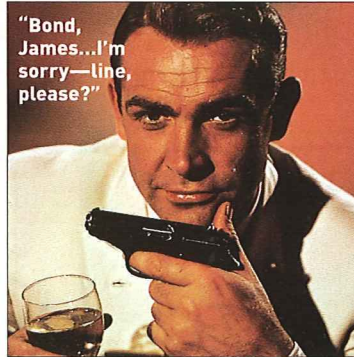

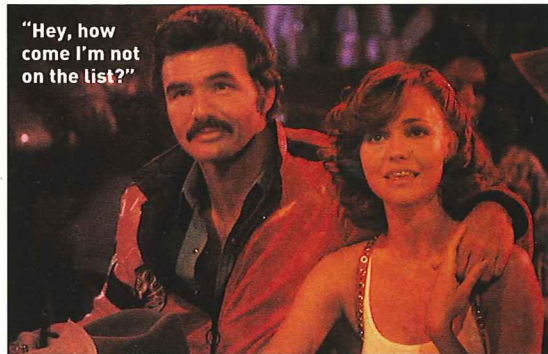
BILLY CARTER Hard-drinking Billy got so wasted while hosting some Libyan diplomats at a Georgia airport that he pissed on the runway.
