Ashton saved his friends' lives

Ashton Kutcher had a blast partying at Mardi Gras in New Orleans in March 2003 with *That '70s Show* co-stars Wilmer Valderrama and Danny Masterson and Tom Hanks' son Colin. But flying back to LA, their vacation turned into a nightmare when their private plane hit major turbulence and the cabin rapidly lost pressure. Some of the oxygen masks didn't work — and Danny and Colin passed out. "I was like, 'What the hell is going on?'" says Ashton, 29, who quickly put a working oxygen mask on Colin, 29, and gave Danny, 31, life-saving CPR. Their frightening ordeal ended when the plane made an emergency landing in El Paso, Texas. Says Wilmer, 27, "Thank God there was a happy ending."



The accident shook Kanye up. "I was scared," he confesses.



"He was the weirdest blue color," says Ozzy's bodyguard Sam Ruston, who gave his boss CPR.

Ozzy was in a coma for eight days

Ozzy Osbourne flipped over the handlebars of an ATV while driving around his Buckinghamshire, England, property in December 2003. The 58-year-old broke his collarbone, six ribs and a vertebra in his neck, there was bleeding into his lungs and the blood supply to his left arm was almost cut off. "He stopped breathing for a minute and a half and there was no pulse," his wife, Sharon, says. When he got to the hospital, he slipped into a coma for eight days. But Ozzy got better — and learned from his mistake: "I'll never go near one of those damn bikes again."



He wasn't wearing a helmet when he had the accident.
