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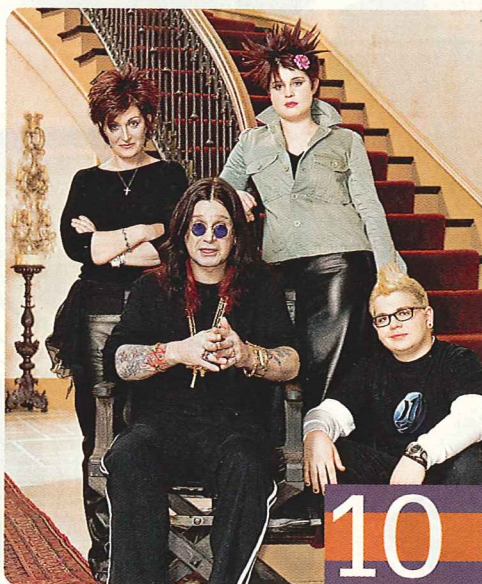

**Origins** Launched in 1908 as a "sports lifestyle" shoe. **Evolution** Basketball hero Chuck Taylor first donned All Stars in 1918. Harlem Globetrotters and NBA stars followed suit. **Comeback** Reissuing iconic styles like the Jack Purcell and the Weapon for spring. **Fashion cred** Designer John Varvatos offers upscale versions in tweed, leather, and vintage fabrics. **Famous fans then** Wilt Chamberlain, James Dean, Jack Kerouac **Famous fans now** P.
