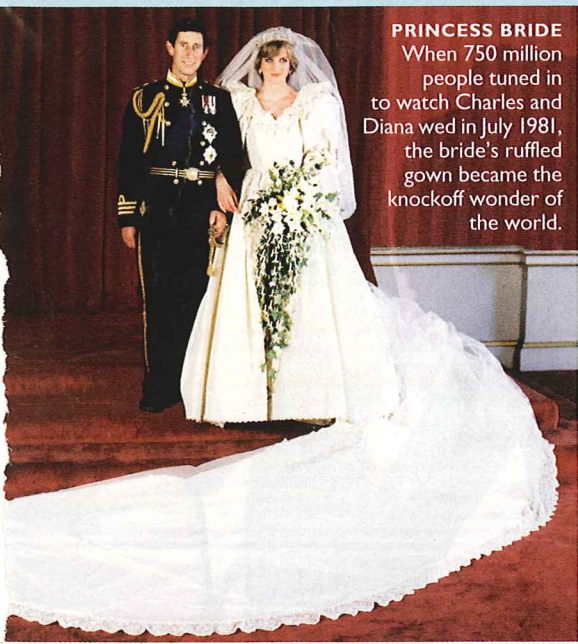


ROYAL FLUSH

PRINCESS BRIDE

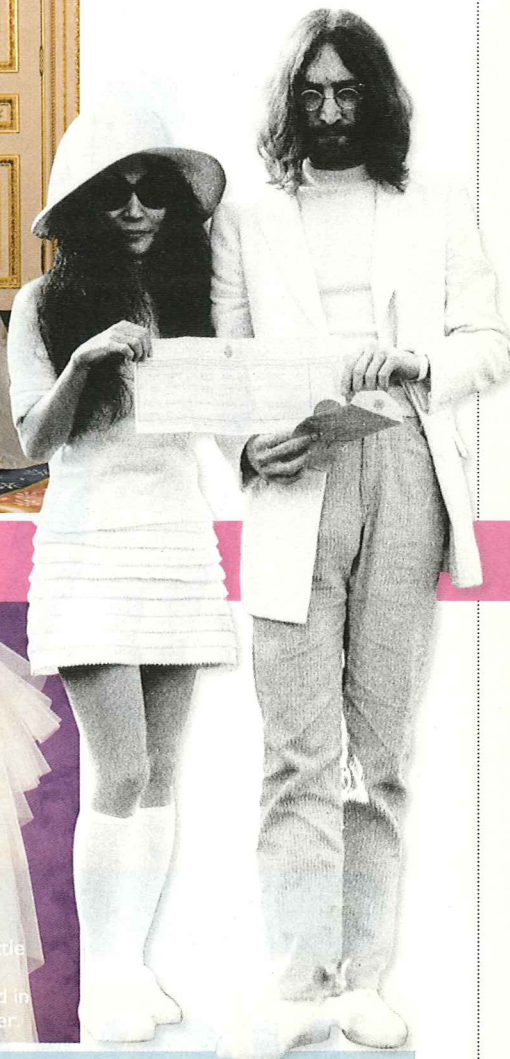
When 750 million people tuned in to watch Charles and Diana wed in July 1981, the bride's ruffled gown became the knockoff wonder of the world.

Finally, Charles and Camilla say "I do!" On her April 2005 wedding day, the bride wisely eschewed white for a pale-blue gown and matching coat.

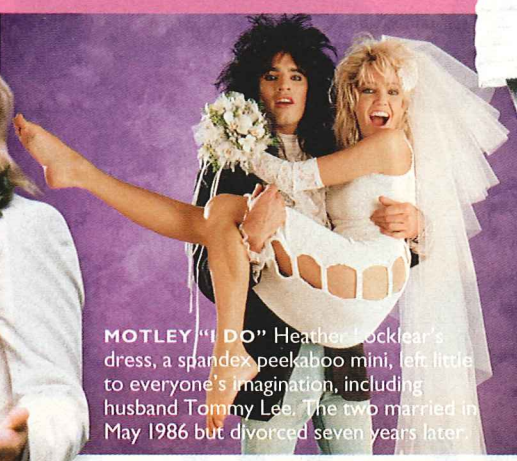
IMAGINE
When Yoko Ono wed John Lennon in March 1969, her dress symbolized peace, love, and sun protection.



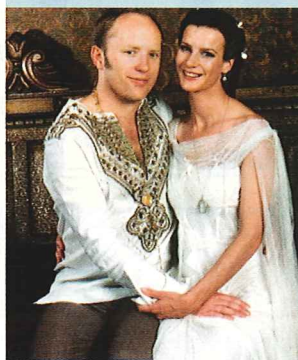
ROCK-AND-ROLL RITUALS



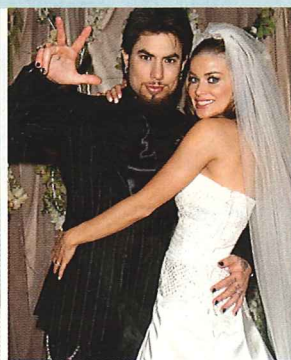
