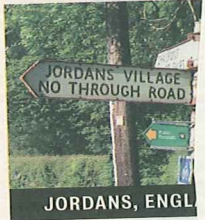

**THE LONDON SUEDE** Thankfully, the boys don't suffer from the "underwhelming live" disease that plagues many other Brit bands. Singer Brett Anderson prances around the stage, crooning elegant pop songs from the London Suede's new album, *Coming Up*, while stellar new guitarist Richard Oakes, who replaced Bernard Butler, fires off sizzling riffs.

Also aboard the Ozzfest crazy train for the daylong extravaganza are Pantera, Type O Negative, Fear Factory, Machine Head and Powerman 5000, and Marilyn Manson on select dates. Ever the party host, Osbourne promises a second stage area, nicknamed Never Never Land, which will feature more music, carnival rides, games and vendors (don't worry, parents, bats aren't on the menu).

**SKUNK ANANSIE/THE ROLLINS BAND** You'd be hard pressed to come up with two more imposing front people on a bill than on this one. It's the 10th anniversary of the Rollins Band, so muscleman/drill sergeant Henry Rollins leads his soldiers through oldies like "Liar" as well as material from their current bone crusher, *Come In and Burn*. England's Skunk Anansie—captained by Skin, the baddest-ass female lead singer around—opens with a set corroded with sociopolitical vitriol that is as much an assault on the eyes as it is on your precious ears.
