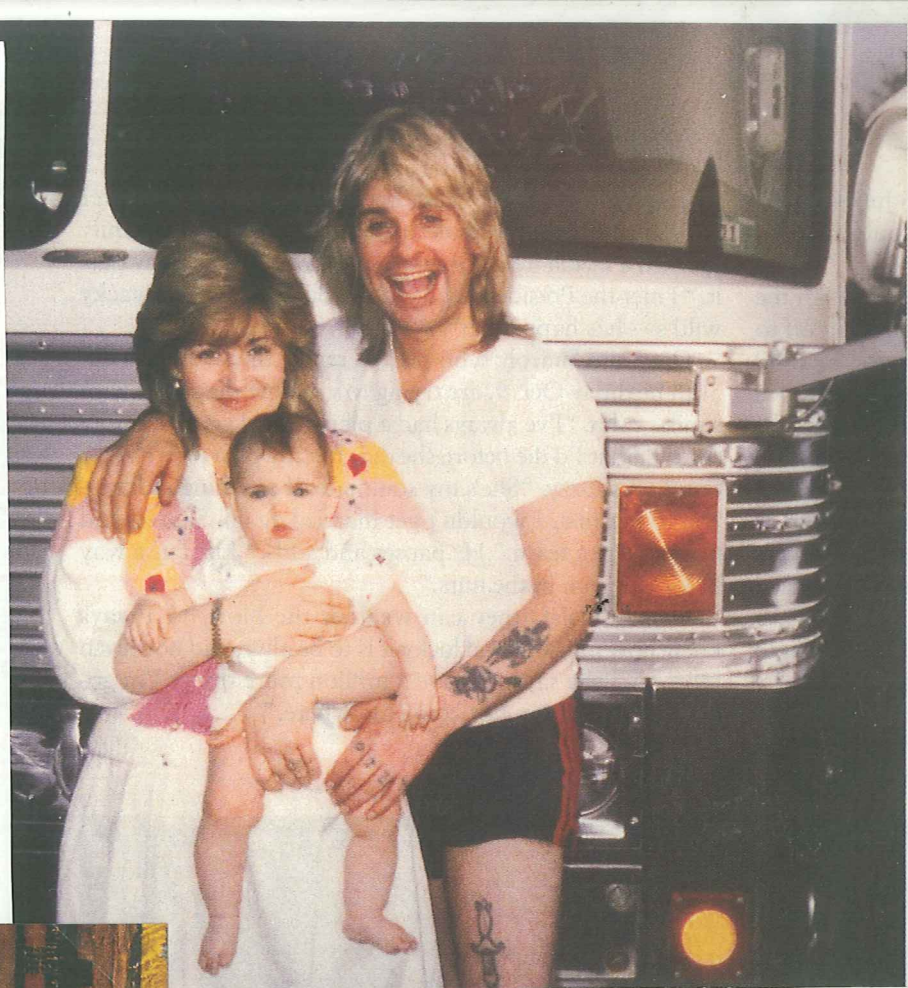




Los 24 millones de Ozzy

Three years later they made it to the altar—barely. “We had five engagement rings, because we’d have arguments and I’d throw them away,” says Sharon, 49. Today, they have “a pact,” says Ozzy, 53. “She’s not allowed to die before me. I couldn’t live without her.”

Download episodes of OTV, which show the Prince of Darkness getting a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame and touring the Far East.
